Storytelling & Mythology — Through prose and ballads, performers weave tall tales!

Bang! — Join the members of Street Drum Corps as they explain the creative process behind their music while performing with recycled and found objects. *This is an extension of the KidZone!*

Intro to Cajun Dance — Learn to dance to the high energy, seductive rhythms of cajun music. Tom and Myra will have you two-stepping and waltzing like a real cajun in no time.



Intro to Harmonica — Learn the basics of harp playing in this hands-on workshop. (A limited number of free instruments will be available on a first come, first served basis.)



Sea Shanty Sing-Along — Chris Ricketts brings his unique versions of traditional folk songs and sea shanties to Ottawa.



Accordion — Local songstress and experienced instructor Megan Jerome will demystify the squeeze box in this intimate workshop.



Delta Blues Basics — Rick Fines presents the building blocks of playing delta blues style guitar. BYOG, or come early borrow one of a limited number of lenders! (A limited number of lender instruments will be available on a first come, first served basis.)



Cigar Box Guitar — TJ Wheeler demonstrates the powers of the cigar box guitar in this participatory jam-a-long session.

The Write Way — Ever wonder where and how and why songwriters craft their tunes? Get the scoop from a diverse group of artists.

My Home Town — Artists from across the continent share songs about the cities and towns they call home.

Sirens with Strings — Tenor guitar, fiddle, mandolin, six-string, charrango, hammered harp: more strings than you can count on your hands and feet!

Southern Folk — Performers explore their ties to southern music traditions such as blues, bluegrass, gospel, country, and more!

Together & Apart — Join a number of groups who will share their experiences working together and going it alone.
